To date we < Prisoners of R.J.D.C.F. > have been on Modified Lockdown with only Officer Escorted Medical and Mental Health Appointments like; Emergency Surgery, Dental and one-on-ones with Primary Clinicians for those inmates who are having problems coping to No Movement from the Cell Life.

There have been multiple inmates in the Mental Health Program that went to the "Crisis Bed" or have done suicidal deeds which include; wrist cutting or hanging themselves due to panicking about the Coronavirus outbreak in < 47 > of California's Prisons. Also there is the fact that < 3 > Medical Staff and a Correctional Officer contracted Covid-19, so the consensus by the inmates is; "It's only a matter of time before this place is
